Skating Rink Rules and Regulations

- No refunds.
- All exits are final - no re-entry to the rink. Keep your ticket with you at all times.
- Patrons must obey the direction of staff and posted notices at all times.
- Park Management and Park Police reserve the right to dismiss any participant due to health & safety concerns, disruptive or unacceptable behavior. Park Management also reserves the right to stop, change, or correct any activity deemed unsafe. This includes canceling skating sessions and denying entry to patrons who pose a safety risk.
- Patrons must treat each other with respect at all times.
 - Bullying, verbal harassment or physical altercations with patrons or park staff are strictly forbidden.
- Trash must be disposed of in proper receptacles. Spitting, littering, and intentionally damaging park property is prohibited.
- Smoking and/or vaping, as well as alcoholic beverages, are not permitted anywhere inside the park.
- All personal belongings must be stored in a locker. Riverbank State Park is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
 - A \$5.00 fee is required for lost locker keys
- Skaters must skate in the same direction, as directed by Park Management.
- Patrons with casts, slings, crutches or recuperating devices are not allowed on the skating rink floor.
- Wheeled devices such as: bicycles, strollers, shopping carts are not allowed on the skating rink floor.
- Skates are not allowed in the bleachers or on the terrace with skates on.
- Figure skating is allowed in the center of the rink only.
- Skating on park grounds or in park building is prohibited.
- Only food and beverage purchased at the rink are allowed to be consumed onsite, and only in designated areas as established by Park Management.
- Audiovisual devices can only be used at the rink with the approval of Park Management.
- Proper attire is required – patrons must have socks in order to rent skates.
- Group counselors must monitor their participants at all times.
